Directions: This form applies to homeless units that are not under the Stewart B McKinney Act. Homeless units identified in a property's Restrictive Use Covenant are required to be rented to qualifying homeless individuals or families where a certification of homelessness can be obtained. If a property owner has exercised due diligence in the search for a qualified homeless family but cannot locate one, and leaving the unit vacant will cause a financial hardship, the owner may apply for a temporary waiver. This form also applies to properties that have located a qualified homeless household but was unable to stabilize the household within 24 months. Rather than put the household back on the street to be homeless again, this waiver can allow up to an additional 24 months.
