Additional Housing Resources

If your household is ineligible to receive <u>Kansas Homeowner Assistance Fund</u> (<u>KHAF</u>) assistance, or you need additional housing assistance, follow the links below to connect with these resources.

<u>United Way 2-1-1 of Kansas</u>: Use this directory, or dial 211 on your cellphone, to find local resources in your area that address hunger, utility assistance, housing concerns, and more.

Kansas Emergency Water Assistance: Find out if your household qualifies and apply to have your water service restored or prevented from disconnection.

<u>Low-Income Energy Assistance (LIEAP)</u>: Find out if your household qualifies and apply for financial assistance with home energy costs.

<u>HUD Housing Counseling Agencies</u>: Certified housing counselors can discuss options if you're having trouble paying your mortgage or managing your reverse mortgage.

Weatherization Assistance Program: Income-eligible homeowners and renters can apply through their region's provider to receive weatherization services and lower utility bills.

Kansas Community Action Agencies: These agencies aim to reduce poverty, revitalize low-income communities, and empower low-income families and individuals to become fully self-sufficient. Find the agency that serves your county here.

<u>Emergency Service Providers</u>: If you or your family are experiencing homelessness or domestic violence, find your nearest shelter and service provider from this list.

<u>Affordable Housing Resources</u>: Access a list of KHRC's affordable properties, search the HUD Resource Locator, or file a tenant complaint.

Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA): Find your county's grantee from the list at the bottom of the page to learn about eligibility guidelines and apply for assistance with rent payments, security deposits, and/or utility deposits.
