## HOW TO ENTER:

This contest is open to any K-12 Kansas student.

Entrants must submit an original, two-dimensional, 8.5 by 11-inch piece of artwork (painting, drawing, or photograph) illustrating what "home" looks like to them, along with a completed entry form. Only one entry is allowed per student.
