

LOWER BILLS. BEAT THE CHILLS.

Weatherization improves heating and cooling efficiency and energy savings by ensuring a home holds in heat and air conditioning while keeping hot and cold air out. The Weatherization Assistance Program is offered at no charge to income-eligible families. Weatherization may include:

- + SEALING DRAFTS AND AIR LEAKS
- + CAULKING DOORS AND WINDOWS
- **+ WEATHERSTRIPPING**
- + TESTING, CLEANING, AND REPAIRING HEATING AND **COOLING SYSTEMS AND WATER HEATERS**
- + INSULATING CEILINGS, WALLS, FLOORS, AND FOUNDATIONS
- + UPGRADING LIGHTING, FANS, AND REFRIGERATORS
